



Information regarding the French grading system / Informations sur le système de notation en France:

The French grading system is based on a 0 (lower grade) to 20 (higher grade) scale. To validate a course, a student must obtain a minimum average grade of 10/20. Grades higher than 16/20 are seldom awarded.

Le système de notation en France emploie un barème de 0 (note la plus basse) à 20 (note la plus haute). Pour valider un cours, l'étudiant doit acquérir un minimum de 10 sur 20. Les notes supérieures à 16/20 sont rarement attribuées.

French Scale	Grade description (mention)*
0 ≤ Grade <10	Ajourné (Failed)
10 ≤ Grade <12	Passable (Pass)
12 ≤ Grade <14	Assez Bien (With Honours)
14 ≤ Grade <16	Bien (High Honours)
16 ≤ Grade <20	Très Bien (Very High Honours)

* The “mention” is an overall quality assessment based on grades earned.
